The Popes on Mercy



When Saint John XXIII solemnly opened the Second Vatican Council he said, "the Bride of Christ (the Church) prefers to use the medicine of mercy rather than arm herself with the weapons of rigor." Blessed Paul VI wrote, "May I at least honor who you are, God of infinite bounty, accepting, and celebrating your sweet mercy." Saint John Paul II affirmed in his encyclical *DIVES IN MISERICORDIA*, that the Church lives an authentic life when it professes and proclaims mercy, the most amazing attribute of the Creator. May the Church lead humanity to the font of mercy." Pope Benedict XVI wrote: "Mercy is the core of the Gospel message, Mercy is the name of God himself. Mercy is the face with which God revealed himself in the Old Testament and then fully in Jesus Christ." Pope Francis declared this year --- a year of Mercy. "By mercy the church is showing her maternal side, her motherly face to a humanity that is wounded. The church does not wait for the wounded to knock on her door, she looks for them on the streets, she gathers them in, she embraces them, and she makes them feel loved." Mercy is the subject closest to the heart of Pope Francis, and is the central teaching of his papacy. "To those who feel they have no need of mercy, Francis counsels, "Even the Pope is a man who needs the mercy of God."
