CHAPLAIN'S COLUMN

SHEPHERDS AND CHRISTMAS



The "poor" is a theme in the Gospel of Saint Luke. Shepherds were poor. They were poor because their life style did not allow them to keep the laws of Jewish society. So, they were outcast. They were a rejected people, who were not given social respect. For St. Luke, shepherds represent all the poor, all who are powerless, all who feel the pain of rejection, all the unwanted.

Luke chose shepherds to be the first to see the Son of God --- Christ the King, born in King David's city of Bethlehem. There, the shepherds stood in awe of the glory and splendor of heaven shining around them.

Then, with trusting and believing hearts they said, "let us go now to see what the Lord has made known to us." Seeing the infant King and Savior, "they honored him, in the place where they found him." May we honor Christ where we find him. Today, we will not find him in a barn's manger. Rather, we will find him living in every human soul. Today, let us go to see what the Lord has made known to us. And there in human beings, a most unlikely place, may we honor him.

The meaning of the Divine Christ sleeping in the manger is the same meaning as the Divine Christ dying on the cross. "see how much I love you." This meaning is expressed profoundly by Cardinal Merry Duval's frequent message to his youth group in Rome (1914). "Always remember, Jesus loves you, with a love, the tenderness of which, you will never be able to understand."
